

eBay proof of monthly sales - Desktop

ADbag only needs your eBay transaction count for the last two full months. We do not need to see your balance.

What to do

1. Use a desktop browser and sign in to eBay.
2. Open Seller Hub, then select Reports.
3. Select Download, then Download report.
4. Choose Source: Orders and Type: All orders.
5. Set the first and last day of the required month.
6. Download the report and open the CSV in Excel.
7. Keep Sale date and Quantity visible; hide buyer, address and financial columns.
8. Exclude any cancelled or fully refunded rows, if shown.
9. Total the Quantity column with =SUM(...).
10. Upload a signed-in report-page screenshot and a redacted screenshot showing the total for each of the last two months.

Before uploading, check this:

Visible: signed-in eBay account, report type and full-month dates.

Visible: Sale date, Quantity column and the final Quantity total.

Hidden: buyer names, addresses, emails, prices, fees and totals.

Upload: two redacted screenshots — never the raw CSV.

Never upload the raw CSV. It contains buyer personal data. Upload redacted screenshots only.

Depop proof of monthly sales - Desktop

ADbag only needs your Depop transaction count for the last two full months. We do not need to see your balance.

What to do

1. Use a laptop or desktop browser and sign in at depop.com.
2. Select the Sell icon to open Selling Hub.
3. Select Stats on the left-hand side.
4. Select Download sales in the top-right corner.
5. Choose the first and last day of the required month.
6. Select Download and open the CSV in Excel.
7. Keep the sale date and quantity visible.
8. Hide buyer username, prices, fees, tax and shipping information.
9. Total the quantity column with =SUM(...).
10. Upload a signed-in Stats screenshot and a redacted screenshot showing the total.

Before uploading, check this:

Visible: signed-in Depop account and the full-month date selection.

Visible: sale date, quantity column and the final quantity total.

Hidden: buyer username, prices, earnings, fees, tax and shipping.

Upload: two redacted screenshots — never the raw CSV.

Never upload the raw CSV. It contains buyer and financial data. Upload redacted screenshots only.

Amazon proof of monthly sales - Desktop

ADbag only needs your Amazon transaction count for the last two full months. We do not need to see your balance.

What to do

1. Use a desktop browser and sign in to Seller Central.
2. Check that the correct Amazon marketplace is selected.
3. Open the menu in the top-left corner.
4. Select Reports, then Business Reports.
5. Under By Date, select Sales and Traffic.
6. Set a custom range from the first to the last day of the required month.
7. Make sure Units Ordered is visible in the report.
8. Hide or crop all revenue and financial figures.
9. Leave the store or marketplace, date range and Units Ordered clearly visible.
10. Upload one clear screenshot with those three details.

Before uploading, check this:

Visible: store or marketplace and the full-month date range.

Visible: Units Ordered — this is the number ADbag needs.

Hidden: Ordered Product Sales and every other financial figure.

Upload: one clear, cropped screenshot.

Use Units Ordered, not sales value or Total Order Items. Hide all financial figures before uploading.

WhatNot proof of monthly sales - Desktop

ADbag only needs your WhatNot transaction count for the last two full months. We do not need to see your balance.

What to do

1. Use a desktop browser and sign in at whatnot.com.
2. Open your profile menu, then Seller Hub.
3. Select Analytics and remain on the Overview tab.
4. Select Edit Dates.
5. Choose the first and last day of the required month, then Update.
6. Set the sales-channel filter to All Sales.
7. Select More, then Order Count.
8. The label may appear as Estimated Order Count on some accounts.
9. Leave your account, date range and Order Count clearly visible.
10. Hide sales and earnings, then upload one clear screenshot.

Before uploading, check this:

Visible: Whatnot account, full-month dates and All Sales filter.

Visible: Order Count (or Estimated Order Count).

Hidden: Estimated Sales, Earnings and all financial figures.

Upload: one clear, cropped screenshot.

Use Order Count, not Estimated Sales. Whatnot analytics may update one to two days later.

Vinted proof of sales - Mobile

ADbag only needs your Vinted transaction count for the last two full months. We do not need to see your balance.

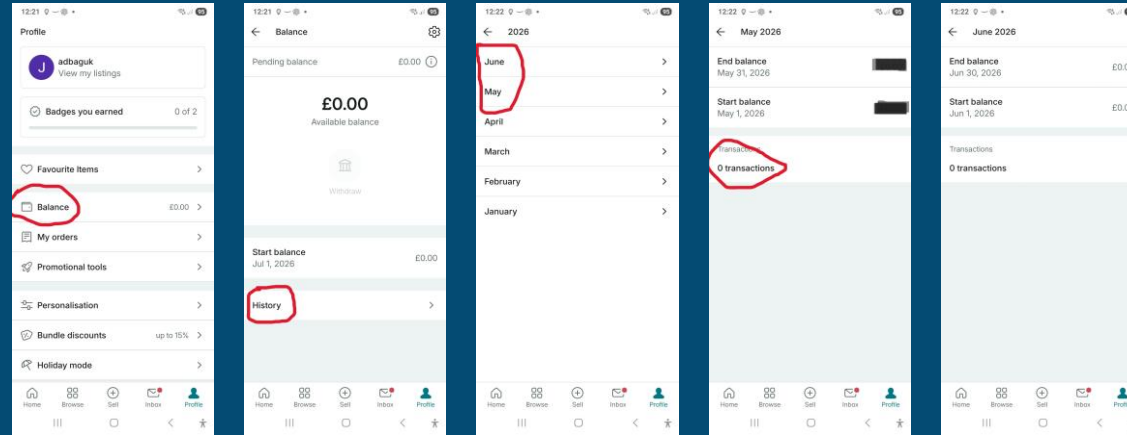
What to do

1. Open the Vinted app on your mobile.
2. Tap Profile at the bottom right.
3. Tap Balance.
4. Tap History, then select 2026.
5. Open the last two full months, one at a time.
6. Take one screenshot for each month.

Example: if it is now mid-July, use May and June.

7. Edit each screenshot and black out the Start balance and End balance figures only.
8. Leave the month/year and Transactions count clearly visible.
9. Save both edited screenshots.
10. Upload both images as proof when completing the Seller Application.

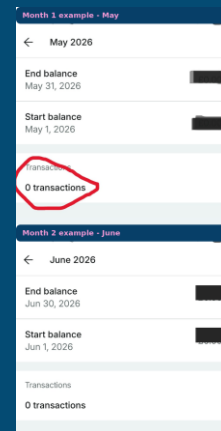

What to do

1. Open Chrome or Safari on your phone.
2. Sign in to Amazon Seller Central.
3. If needed, choose Request Desktop Website.
4. Check the correct Amazon marketplace is selected.
5. Open the menu, then Reports > Business Reports.
6. Under By Date, select Sales and Traffic.
7. Set the first and last day of the required month.
8. Make sure Units Ordered is visible.
9. Hide or crop all revenue and financial figures.
10. Keep marketplace, month and Units Ordered visible in one screenshot.

WhatNot proof of monthly sales - Mobile

What to do

2. Sign in at whatnot.com — Seller Analytics is web-only.
3. If needed, choose Request Desktop Website.
4. Open profile menu > Seller Hub > Analytics.
5. Remain on Overview, then select Edit Dates.
6. Choose the required month, then Update.
7. Set the sales-channel filter to All Sales.
8. Select More, then Order Count.
9. The label may be Estimated Order Count on some accounts.
10. Keep account, month and Order Count visible; hide financial figures.
